Directions to American Legion

GSP to exit 82, route 37 east. Go east for several miles & go over causeway bridge. Follow signs for Seaside Heights. Road swings under overpass briefly heading north. Make 1st right & then left at where the road splits onto Bay Blvd. Go a few blocks north & American Legion Post is on the right. Please park on side streets.

Directions to the 4x4 Brighton Beach Access

Traveling from the American Legion. Head east a few blocks until Ocean Terrace. Make a right onto Ocean Terrace and head south. Ocean Terrace turns into North Ocean Ave. At the corner of Brighton Ave. and North Ocean Ave., make left onto the ramp for beach access. Air down to 15-18lbs of pressure and enter beach access. Be careful of sun bathers and pedestrians. Ask for assistance if needed. Do not litter!

Directions for Air Pumps & Gas Station

Coming from the Brighton Ave. beach access, go straight 1 or 2 blocks to Central Ave. Make a left turn onto Central Ave. traveling south. Go around municipal complex, continuing on Central Ave. Lukoil gas station is on the left side. Pumps are located on the right of the garage. The air is free at this time, but if gasoline is needed, please patronize him with a fill up. --- <'//>X
